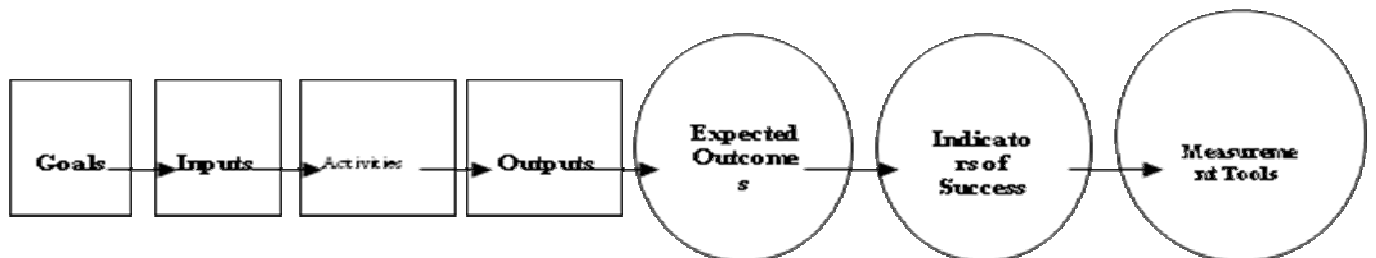
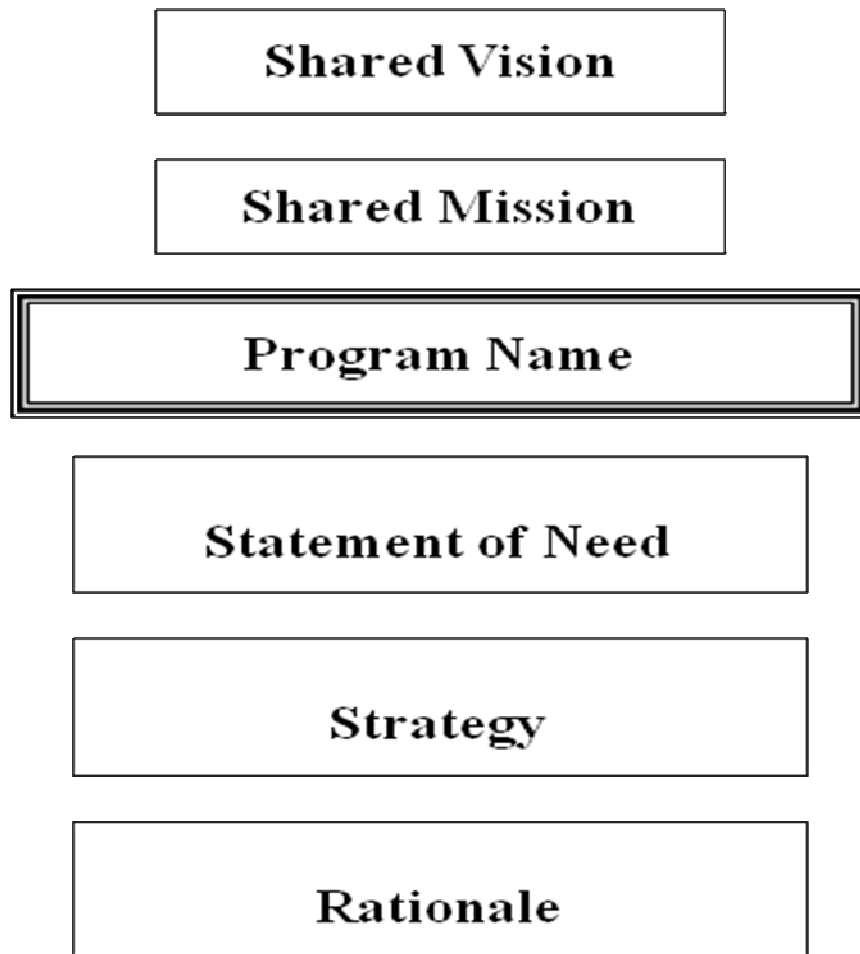


# Logic Model



## Logic Model Definitions

<b>Agency Vision</b>	Desired social condition
<b>Agency Mission</b>	Your unique role in working towards the desired social condition
<b>Statement of Need</b>	Problem statement, description of the situation you wish to change
<b>Strategy</b>	The approach(es) you will use to meet this need/change this problem
<b>Rationale</b>	An explanation of why you believe this approach will work
<b>Goals</b>	A general statement of what you are attempting to achieve
<b>Inputs</b>	Resources dedicated to the program
<b>Activities</b>	Specific ways/actions you will use to work towards your goals
<b>Outputs</b>	The direct product of your activities, usually measured by volume of work accomplished
<b>Expected Outcomes</b>	Statements which describe the difference your intervention will make in the short term, intermediate and long term
<b>Indicators of Success</b>	Concrete things you can see or hear, which provide evidence that you are achieving your outcomes- often referred to as performance measures
<b>Measurement Tools</b>	Means by which you collect information to measure your success
